


Moss Killer-Tarmac Cleaner

DESCRIPTION

USE INSTRUCTIONS

Apply only when surface is dry. Dilute 1 part Moss Killer to 10 parts water for light growth or 1 part Moss Killer to 6 parts water for heavy growth. Apply using a garden sprayer or watering can, ensure the surface been treated is saturated especially when using on heavy moss and allowed to work for 4-6 hours before rain arrives. Kills within two days, heavy moss takes up to 1 week to turn brown, Remove heavy moss using a stiff brush and dispose into a compost bin.



STORAGE & PACKAGING

Moss killer is available in 1, 2.5, 5 & 25 litre containers. Store in original containers; Store in a cool dry area; Keep container tightly closed in a safe place.
